We are delighted to inform you that River East Transcona School Division is implementing a new program, initiated and funded by the province, for the 2024-25 school year: the **Universally Accessible School Nutrition Program**.

This initiative's main goal is to ensure that no child goes through the school day hungry, helping them focus better and perform well in their academic year. By providing free and healthy supplemental snacks to all students, regardless of perceived needs, the program aims to:

- ✓ Reduce hunger among students.
- ✓ Follow Canada's Food Guide and Canada's nutritional guidelines.
- ✓ Accommodate food allergies and intolerances.
- ✓ Accommodate cultural and religious dietary needs.
- ✓ Be barrier free and stigma free.
- ✓ Support overall well-being and academic success.
- ✓ Respect public health guidelines including following food safety protocols and procedures.

Scheduled to start in the first part of the third week of September, your child will have access to healthy snacks provided by the school.

Parents and guardians should know that this program is meant to fill gaps. While schools will offer snack support, it supplements what is offered from home. Parents and caregivers should continue sending food with their child, knowing the program will address any additional needs.

As the year progresses, we will be sharing periodic updates with you about this important support in your child's school.
