- c. If the user has forgotten their password and doesn't have an email address on file, they will need to contact the school.
- 6. Data Errors If student contacts find any errors in the data (attendance, report cards, etc.) please notify the school office.











#### **CONFERENCE MANAGER**

A **Parent Account** is required to use the Conference Manager. However, you only need to go through the registration process the first time you use the system. **To register** in the Conference Manager, use the link above and click the "Register Now" button and complete the registration form. Your login credentials (email and password) will remain in the system to make it easy to access the Conference Manager in the future. Please ensure you input all of your children currently attending Arthur Day Middle School. Choose the appropriate school from the drop-down menu for each child.

**Note:** You can update your Parent Account at any time by logging in and updating your profile.

#### Can't remember your password?

If you already have a Parent Account, click on the link above, select "Forgot your password" and enter the email address you used to register in the system. You will then receive an email containing instructions for resetting your password. If you do not receive an email, you might have entered an email address the system does not recognize. Be sure to add <a href="mailto:appointments@schoolsoft.com">appointments@schoolsoft.com</a> to your Address Book. This will over-ride any spam filters that might be blocking the email. If the problem persists, please contact the office and ask them to access your Parent Account, confirm your email address and reset your password.

#### Step 1 - Conference Manager Opens - Friday, March 1st 6:00 am.

If you used the Conference Manager in the past, your email and password are still in the system. You can simply access the Conference Manager using the link above.

#### **Step 2** – Book your Conference start time.

Select the homeroom teacher with whom you want to book an appointment start time.

You will see your student's homeroom teacher's schedule, the amount of meeting times are limited and are booked on a first come first served basis. After booking your appointments you can print off your schedule. You will also receive an email confirming your bookings. You can log into the system at any time to view your bookings, print, cancel or re-schedule appointments. Instructions may be found on our school website.

It's hands on, challenging and messy – all things we love to practice in the art room!












#### 1. ADMS Used Book Sale


















### Join our MYRCA Book Club!



#### **ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT**

Managing the use of electronic equipment in school is essential to maintaining an environment free from interruption of teaching and learning opportunities and to respecting the privacy and safety of all students. As a general rule, the use of electronic equipment is not permitted during regular class time. Only under special permission will students be allowed to use these devices during class time.

Cell Phones: Student use of cell phones is not permitted during class time, while on divisional



transportation, or during out-of-school sponsored activities unless directed by a teacher. It is expected that communication with students during class time will occur through the office. Cell phones should be turned off and stored in lockers during regular class time.

Staff members may confiscate electronic communications devices from students if they are used for unauthorized purposes or at unauthorized times.







#### **ATTENDANCE**

**Daily school attendance is important for all students to gain the full benefits of educational instruction.** Students are expected to be punctual for school in the morning, after lunch and be on time for all their classes. Arthur Day Middle School opens at 8:35 a.m. and students are expected to be in their homeroom classes by 8:45 a.m. Likewise, lunch ends at 12:15 and afternoon homeroom begins at 12:20 p.m.

#### **LUNCHTIME EXPECTATIONS**

Lunchtime begins at 11:30 am. Students can go home for lunch, or they may eat inside of the school at the lunch tables.

Students may leave school property and walk to a local establishment if they have parental permission to do so. Please have a conversation with your child about your expectations during lunchtime. Clubs and activities also run during lunch, so please send a bag lunch on these days. If students choose to go off of school property for lunch, it is the expectation that they will remain off of school property until 12:15 pm.
