Dear ADMS families,

We just wanted to share some opening information for the start of the school year.

On Tuesday, September 2nd we will have our doors open for School Years Eve between 3:00 and 5:00. This often helps get the return to school jitters out, allowing students to come into the building, find their way to their classroom, meet their teacher, and say hi to peers as they prepare to begin this next school year.

School officially begins on Wednesday, September 3rd. The morning, as has been tradition here, is reserved for grade 6 students only to help them get acquainted and comfortable in their transition to middle school. The school day begins with entry at 8:35, students will be asked to wait outside if they arrive earlier than this. We have staff outside supervising as of 8:30, if your child requires additional supervision, please do not send them before this time. The school day ends at 3:10 and we would just like to remind you as we re-open that the back parking lot is not for pickup at the end of the day. Please kindly park on St. Martin or Whitehall to wait for your child if you are picking them up.
