### **CREDITS**

Students are required to have a minimum of 30 credits (21 compulsory and 9 optional) to graduate. Students planning to attend post-secondary education require 5 courses at the 40S level, excluding Physical Education. The courses required for university and college admission vary. It's the responsibility of parents and students to ensure they have the required courses for admission into university/college.
