Dear KEC Parents/Guardians,

High school credits are essential for students to graduate. This year KEC is offering a new **Credit Recovery Program** that allows students the opportunity to make up for failed courses and stay on track for graduation. Our new program will be teacher-led and will have integral curricular concepts re-taught. This will ensure that students are prepared to continue their learning in these subjects going forward. The Credit Recovery Program differs from the previous Individualized Self-Paced Learning (ISPL) model which is no longer being offered.

Here are some key details, requirements, and expectations:

- Students need to have a grade of 40% or higher to qualify for the credit recovery program.
- Any grade below 40% will require the course be taken again, either through summer school, online at the student's expense, or at KEC.
- Credit recovery will be offered **during the lunch hour in RM 201**.
- **Daily attendance is mandatory and will be monitored!** As this is a brief intervention, students who have **two absences** will be removed from the program and will have to redo the course.
- Absences will be reported via the school dialer.
- Students will recover their credit, with a final mark of 50%. It is recommended that students who require a better grade redo the entire course.
- Students are responsible for attending the appropriate Credit Recovery session.



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Courses will be scheduled in three week blocks as indicated in the table below:
