Principal's Report

Updates:

- Current student enrollment is approximately 1,393.
- The current administrative team is made up of Cara Colorado, Joanne Zahaiko, Scott McMullan and Marjorie Millman. Cara Colorado will remain with KEC until December 22 after which she will be replaced by Kristin Mann-Simpson.
- Teachers and students who undertook the annual trip to Canmore, AB returned during the week ended 24.09.2023.
- Parents who showed up for the Meet-the-Teacher event were appreciated for their presence and contribution to the successful outing.
- On the sporting front, football, volleyball as well as track and field are now all underway.
- A club fair which provided leverage for a number of clubs within the school to join to promote themselves and invite other students, was held on 13.09.2023.
- Parents are notified that when incidents occur in KEC, efforts are made to send out information to parents ASAP. However, due to confidentiality reasons, details of such incidents or the resolution thereof are not usually shared.
- Deriving from this, parents are hereby informed that the presence of police cars on KEC's premises does not always portend any problems as the school has a Resource Officer who is a member of the Winnipeg Police.

Committees:

- KEC has three (3) key priority areas namely Safe and Caring Schools, Educational Practices as well as Planning for Diversity. These priorities have given rise to the establishment of eight (8) committees.
- Safe and Caring Schools have Positive Behavior Intervention Supports and Mental Health committees.
- Educational Practices have Literacy, Numeracy and Assessment committees.
- Planning and Diversity have Indigenous Academic Achievement [IAA], English as an Additional Language [EAL] and Justice, Equity, Diversity and Inclusion [JEDI] committees.

Staffing:

• KEC is currently at the point of finalizing staffing in the Resource teacher term position.

- Based on the donation request for Staff appreciation carried out last Spring, a total of \$1,810 was collected.
- For the Staff Appreciation Dinner & snacks for the following day, which was a resounding success, \$847.40 was spent.
- The sum of \$170 was also spent to buy treats for all staff members during the Meet-the-Teacher event in September
- The remaining balance of the donations, approximately \$800, will be used for a treat day for staff in November.

• New members wanted to know the basis for the fundraisers and it was reiterated that they were not profit-making ventures. Funds collected are donations from the KEC families, essentially utilized to show appreciation to staff and give them a sense of belonging.
