Dear Murdoch Families:

*IMPORTANT FIRST DAY INFORMATION

Welcome back to our students and a very special welcome to all our new students who are attending Murdoch MacKay Collegiate for the first time in the 2024 - 2025 school year. We are looking forward to having all our students back in the building again after what was hopefully a refreshing summer!

The first day of school will be **DIFFERENT** for students in each grade. When students attend school, they will be entering into the building at a specific time and will go directly to their Teacher Advisor Group. Each student's Teacher Advisor is listed on their timetable from June 2024. With our switch to PowerSchool there is currently no Parent Portal available. All students will receive a printed copy of their timetable in their Teacher Advisor meeting on Wednesday.

School opens to students on Wednesday, September 4th, 2024 - Day 2. Regular schedules for students will begin on Thursday, September 5, 2024, which will be Day 1.

Grade 9 Students: Grade 9 students will report to school at **9 am on Wednesday, September 4**. They will move directly to their Teacher Advisor classroom. We will have staff and leadership students on hand to help them when they arrive. Grade 9 students will tour the building, meet in small group assemblies, and have the opportunity to meet their classroom teachers. All Grade 9 students will be dismissed for the day at 12:15 pm.

Grade 10, 11 and 12 Students: All remaining students will start school on **Wednesday, September 4 at 1:17 pm,** and report directly to their Teacher Advisor Classroom. Students will meet in Grade level assemblies and have the opportunity to meet their classroom teachers. Students will be dismissed at 3:29 pm.

Student Fees

Student fees are \$50 for the school year. These will be collected in each student's Teacher Advisor group on the first day of classes or can be paid online through the Parent Portal.

Convocation Fees

Convocation fees of \$40 will be collected in January for all students who are on the Graduation list at that time. These fees help cover the cost of our school-based convocation services. More information will follow for Grade 12 students later in the year.

Lunch

Students are encouraged to go home for lunch if possible. Students are encouraged to eat in the cafeteria area or the Cove. Food is not permitted in the Library Learning Commons or the Gymnasiums.

A Regular School Day

A regular school day at Murdoch MacKay has six periods. Having six periods allow us to schedule classes in Period 4 (formerly our lunch hour) and allow for more timetable flexibility for students. **This does not affect our Grade 9 students, who will all have lunch during Period 4**. The period times are listed below.

Period 6	2:25 – 3:29

We ask that students arrive 10 minutes prior to their first scheduled period. At the end of the students' schedule, they are asked to leave school grounds, and to avoid congregating in and around the building.
