IMPORTANT SCREENING REQUIREMENTS for ALL VOLUNTEERS

Here are the screening requirements for all RETSD volunteers:

- **Child Abuse Registry (CAR) checks are required annually (free – come to the school)**
- **Criminal Record Checks (CRC) with Vulnerable Sector Check are required every two (2) years (come to the school for a letter to waive fees if completing via ESP RCMP)**
