E-MAIL CONTACT INFORMATION – please ensure the school has your current e-mail address. Our **primary form of communication is by e-mail** as well as our school website. Please update, as necessary.

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 3 - We are excited to invite you to our School Year's Eve Teacher Meet and Greet, a drop-in event on **September 3rd from 4:30 to 6:00 pm**. This event is designed to reduce anxiety for students by providing an opportunity to meet their teachers before the first full day of school. Students will also have the chance to learn where their classes are located and take a walk around the school to become familiar with their new surroundings. We look forward to seeing you there and starting the school year off on a positive note.

PARKING LOT – The parking lot is off limits to VG student drop off and pick up due to school buses, staff and daycare children entering the parking lot. Please drop your student off on Antrim Rd. near Louelda Street or London Street. Another ideal drop off location is on Reay Crescent. Thank you for considering the safety of our students.

STUDENT ARRIVAL and DEPARTURE - Unless students are involved in a planned activity with school staff, they should arrive at school no earlier than 8:30 a.m. The front doors of the school will be open at 8:40 a.m. with the opening bell. Dismissal is at 3:25pm and students should leave the school property within 10 minutes unless involved in a supervised extra-curricular activity after school.

If students have appointments that require dismissal prior to the end of the day, Parents or Guardians need to contact the school. **Text messages from student phones are not acceptable for dismissal**. Parents will be notified when it is necessary for a student to go home, for either illness or appointments. When leaving the school, it is important to sign out in the office.

CALLBACK SYSTEM – We will communicate absences to parents after the morning and afternoon attendance. We ask parents to contact the school prior to the start of the school day if your child will be absent. **There is a 24-hour answering machine** or you may contact us through email to **vg@retsd.mb.ca**. We appreciate your cooperation in reporting your child's absence so that we can maintain accurate attendance, which has a direct impact on student safety.

LATES - We strongly encourage students to <u>arrive at school on time</u> to minimize the disruption to learning during the school day. Students are asked to be seated in their Den when the bell sounds at 8:50 a.m. and 12:40 p.m. Frequent late arrivals will result in a loss of privileges or communication with a parent/guardian.

LUNCH - It is strongly **recommended that grade 7 and 8 students stay on school grounds** during the lunch hour. Students that stay at school will be supervised by staff during this time. If students leave the building at lunch, they are expected to **be back at school on time for afternoon classes**. Expectations for behavior in the community remain in place over the lunch hour even if students choose to leave the school grounds.

Grade 6 students are expected to remain on school grounds, for the entire school year.

Cell Phones - Upon entering the school, students are required to **keep their cell phones in their lockers**. Cell phones may only be **used for educational purposes with teacher permission**. Social media use is strictly prohibited during school hours. After repeated warnings, a student's cell phone may be confiscated, and parents will be notified and may be required to pick it up from the office at the end of the day. We appreciate your cooperation in supporting our efforts to maintain an optimal educational environment.

MESSAGES – The office phone should only be used in an emergency. Please try to make all necessary arrangements before school. **Students cannot accept phone calls during class time**. Calls can be returned during lunch and after school. As per our technology policy, students will not be allowed to use their cell phones without teacher permission.

In closing, thank you for your anticipated support as we strive to create an excellent school experience for your child. Your attention to the information included in this letter will further enhance our ability to program in the best interest of all our students safely and effectively.
