#### Digital Citizenship and Literacy-

As we continue to help support our students through the Digital World, we will be focusing our attention over the next few weeks to Digital Citizenship and Literacy, and the responsibilities of using technology in a safe and respectful manner. Increasingly, technology has become an important learning tool in our schools. We recognize that the use of these tools both in and out of our schools requires a new set of skills to use the technology for learning in a safe, ethical, and purposeful way. Please know that we have devices at school to support learning, however, if a student decides to bring in their own personal devices, that they do so at their own risk. We encourage all families to revisit the guidelines we use at school, as this framework may assist in keeping expectations consistent between home and school.


