- Our educators are committed to engage all students through authentic, inquiry based and meaningful learning. Our Student, Teacher, Family Conferences are centered around celebrations of learning.

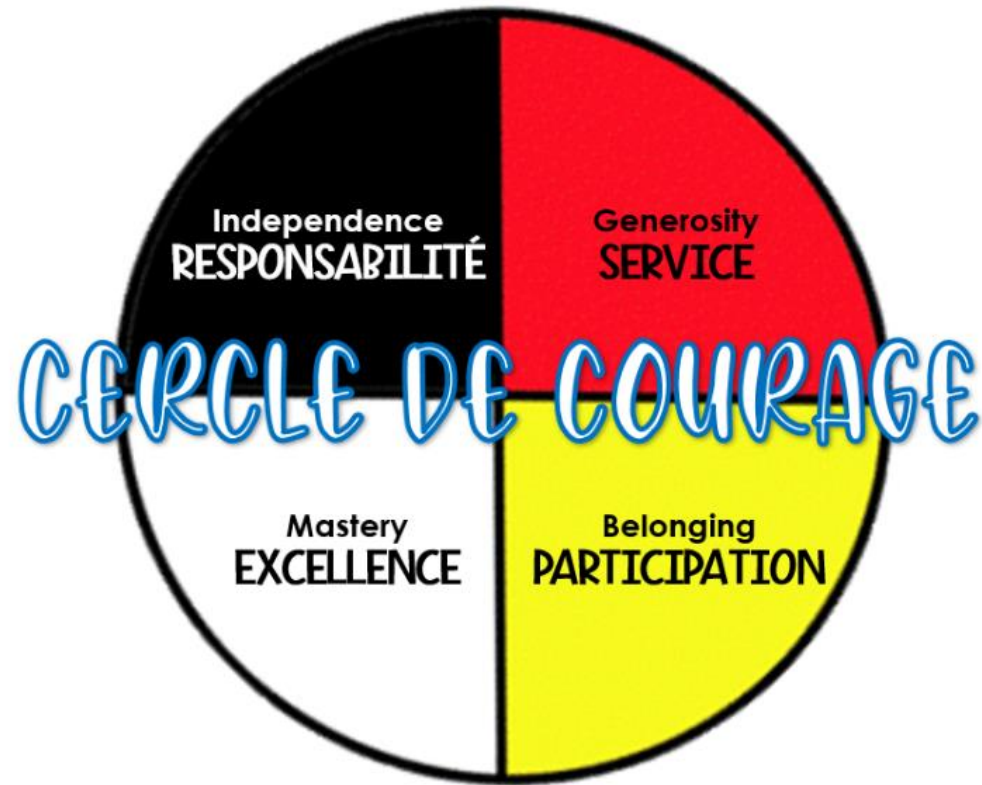

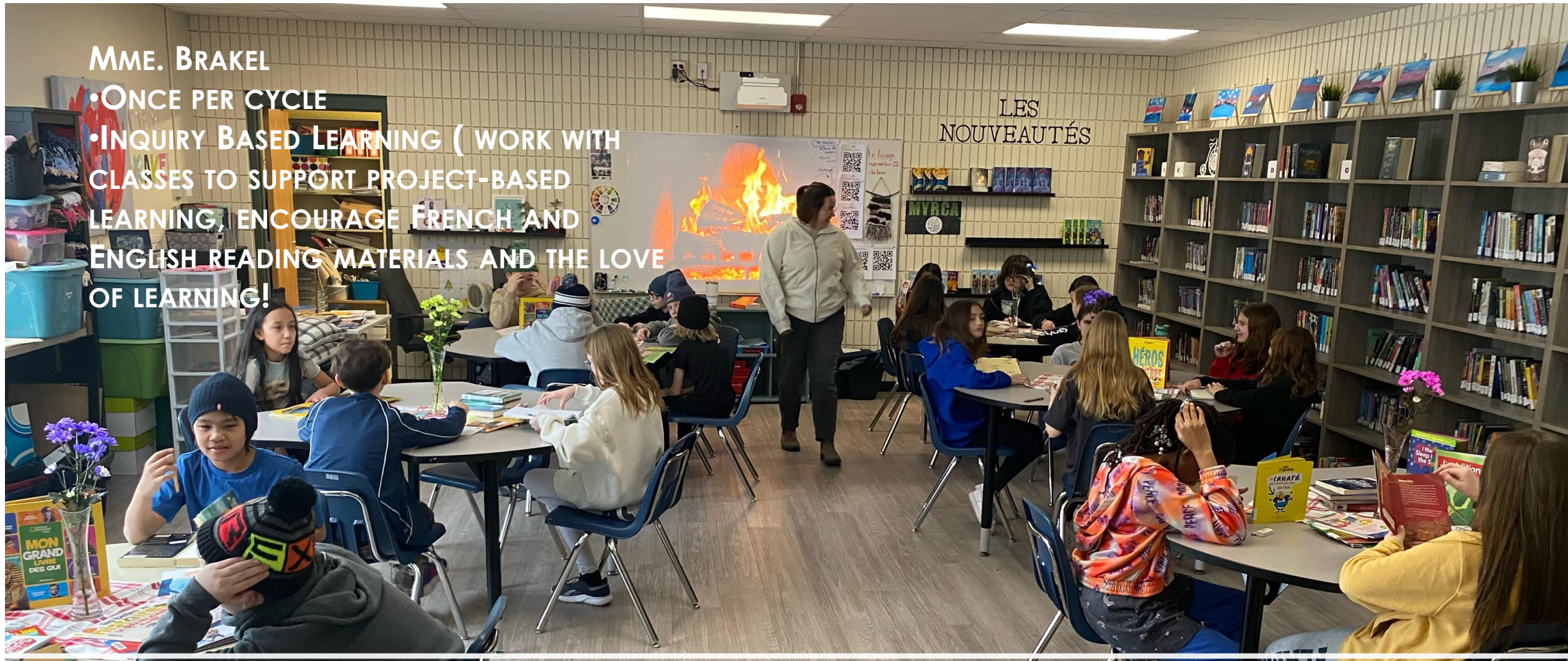
