Dear Parents/Guardians and Buckeyes students,

WELCOME NEW AND RETURNING FAMILIES TO THE 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR!

We hope all our families have had a safe and restful summer. As we prepare to welcome our students in September, we continue to be committed to providing and sustaining a safe and positive school environment for students, staff, and community members. We would like to share some information as we prepare for our **students to return to school on Wednesday, September 4th, 2024**.

STUDENT SCHEDULES

- Student schedules were sent on the June 19th.
- Please ensure your child has a copy of their timetable (paper or electronic) when they come to classes on September 4th. Students will be asked to report to their TA class at their designated time (see schedule below).
- Student Council (STUCO) members will be available to assist students to their TA classrooms on the first day of classes.
- Student Services will ONLY be available from Tuesday, August 27th Thursday, August 29th to make changes to timetables for the following reasons/errors:
 - Missing required course (core courses for graduation)
 - o Missing a course required for graduation or post-secondary education
- NOTE: Timetable changes will NOT be made to accommodate teacher or friend requests, work schedules, requests for spares at a given time, or to change option courses.
- The Student Services Department will be available from 8:30am-3:00pm on the following days. Appointments must be made on the Parent Conference Management system. It is located on our website and will be available on August 19th at 9:00am. If you're unable to get an appointment, please email your Student Services contact and they will contact you the first week of school.
 - o Grade 12 students → August 27th and August 28th
 - o Grade 11 students → August 28th and August 29th
 - o Grade 10 students → August 28th and August 29th
 - \circ Grade 9 students \rightarrow no timetable changes will occur.





Additional Course Request – Grade 10-12 Students ONLY

- Due to the high enrollment and limited space in classes, students will not be able to request additional courses prior to the commencement of classes.
- Students may be able to request additional courses once all timetable requirements (compulsory courses) have been met for all students.
- Students who are requesting an additional course will be required to fill in the Microsoft FORMS starting at noon on September 4th until Monday, September 9th at noon. No late submissions will be accepted.
- Microsoft FORMS (QR codes will be posted on the CMMC TEAMS site and outside of Student Services).
- If space allows, Student Services will be using a wait list system to fill requests with the priority being placed on graduation and postsecondary requirements. Students are asked to follow their current schedules until they have met with Student Services if they are requesting a possible change. Please note that due to high enrollment in all courses, requests may not be granted.

LOCKERS

- Lockers will be available for students upon request during their TA meeting on the first day of classes.
- Any requests for lockers after the first day will have to be made with a secretary in the office.

ENTRANCE

- All exterior doors are open for students to enter between 8:00am-8:30am.
- All doors will be locked at approximately 8:30am, except for the main doors on Roch Street. Any students arriving after 8:30am, will be required to use the main doors on Roch Street.

LUNCH HOUR

- There is a designated period 4 lunch hour in most student schedules. The exception to this would be for some students who have chosen options in Music or Technology courses. These students may have a period 4 class and have a designated lunch period during another time slot.
- Students may eat their lunch in the cafeteria, library, designated classrooms, or may choose to go home during this time.
- Microwaves will be available. Due to the limited number of microwaves, we recommend students bring a lunch that does not require heating.
- Cafeteria service will continue to be offered.

STUDENT UNSCHEDULED TIME

• Students who have spares throughout the day are asked to go to the cafeteria or library.

TECHNOLOGY AND MEDIA

- Office 365 will continue to be our primary communication and collaboration tool for students and teachers. Students have access to the full functionality of Office 365 applications (E.g.: Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Outlook, Teams, One Note).

ATTENDANCE

If a student is going to be absent, the **parent/guardian** of the student is asked to **call the school attendance line at 204-663-4068** either the night before or the day of the absence before 9:00am. The attendance line accepts calls 24 hours a day. Please note that siblings cannot call in to excuse a student.

If a student will be absent for an extended period of time, students are asked to meet with their Student Services contact to get an Extended Absence form.
