## FRENCH IMMERSION GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- For Grade 10-12 students in the 2024-2025 school year, a minimum of 14 credits from courses taught in French are required to obtain the provincial diploma in French Immersion. Students must study Français and Mathematics at the Grades 9, 10, 11 and 12 levels.
- New: Grade 9 students in the 2024-2025 school year, will require a minimum of 15 credits from courses taught in French for their French Immersion Diploma.
- All Sciences, Social Science and option courses (if offered in French) in Grades 11 and 12 must be taken in French.
