1) Welcome, Call to Order, Time: 5:31pm

2) Old Business

- Approval of Oct 14 Minutes:
 - *Approved* - 1st: Crystal 2nd: Ramona
- Teacher Survey:
 - 18 anonymous responses to the survey.
 - No negative responses. A number of responses asked for dry-erase markers for the classroom as well as the possibility of CSA partially funding for buses when it comes to field trips.
 - Thoughts from Admin: CSA could fund for one event for next year because we need to see what we have raised and what we could afford (Admin says it's about \$3000 to give everyone **or** \$3 per student to cover costs for transportation), to give out for next school year
- Connection Council Meeting:
 - Amanda Y and Crystal attended Oct 22nd; it was a gathering of RETSD parent council groups to get together and discuss different topics. This meeting was mainly information based and in lecture format.
 - Discussed RETSD strategic plan for 2025-2030, Leadership governance and management, Role of the board of trustees, Role of senior administration, Board priorities, and explained that the board of trustees works for you, the parent.
 - Next meeting will be January 13th, 2026 and topics will be: PAC Engagement Strategies, Student Transitions Between Schools, Managing Events and Hot Lunch Programs, Lunch Programs, Transportation

1. Remembrance Day Assembly – we had a beautiful school wide assembly on TEAMS for all students and staff on Monday, Nov 10/25. Our EY students and our MY students participated in powerful presentations, that included music, the spoken word, art and special video clips. Thank you to our music teacher, Mrs. Neufeld, along with many of our adults, who worked committedly to put this together.
2. Student Led Conferences are coming up this week on Thursday, Nov 27 (after school/evening in person). There are no conferences the following Friday morning, as that is not a coordinated/admin day. Conferences are booked online through Conference Manager. Parents must register to create an account for their child(ren) and then book a time for a conference. 3. Report Cards are available as of Thursday, Nov 20. Please review your child(ren)'s report in its entirety before our student led conferences, so you are aware of the details in the report card.

Staff Professional Development - Our Nov 7, we focused on a school wide book study our staff have been reading about fostering resilience amongst students, and teaching from a trauma informed lens. Staff will be engaged in conversations around those documents, as well as having planning time for term 2.
