Convocation Statement Guidelines

Your statement must:

- ▶ Use appropriate language and topics
- ▶ Be **30–70 words** (about **10–30 seconds** when read aloud)
- ▶ Relate to your experiences at **CMMC**

Important to Remember

- ▶ The statement will be read **aloud by a staff member** as you cross the stage
- ▶ It must be written **about you, not** in first person
- ▶ No “I” statements

What You Could Include

- ▶ Thank someone important (family, teacher, coach, friends)
- ▶ Recall a memorable CMMC experience
- ▶ Share personal growth or a reflection on high school
- ▶ Mention future plans (school, work, travel, career)

Submission Reminder

- ▶ **No submission = no statement read** (only your name will be announced)
- ▶ Take this opportunity to make your convocation moment your own
- ▶ **Questions? See or contact Mrs. Pellaers (Room 4)**

CONVOCAATION STATEMENT

- ▶ At the graduation ceremony, as students are crossing the stage to collect their diploma, a brief description of their time at CMMC will be read by a staff member. We want this description to give a sense of your involvement and personal experience at Miles Mac. Use the link below to record your convocation statement. All statements will be proofread and approved by staff prior to publication
 - Thank someone important to you
 - Recall a specific experience
 - Say something about yourself & what you plan to do

Sample: *Alex enjoyed her time at Miles Mac, especially on the softball team and the CAC committee. She would like to thank Mr. Smith for making sewing class the best part of her day. She would also like to thank her family and friends for their support during these 4 years. Alex will be attending Brick College this fall to become an underwater welder.*

PROVINCIAL ACADEMIC GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Graduation Requirements (for all students)

Minimum # credits to graduate: 30

FI Students need 14 credits in Français to receive an FI diploma (at least one option in French at the Grade 12 level); Must have Français and Mathématiques at all 4 levels

Grade 12 compulsory courses must be completed - English, Math, Phys Ed, two 40S options (three 40S options if you want to go to university)

At least 1 option needs to be at the Grade 11 (30S) level

Student has final responsibility to ensure all credits have been earned

Reach out to Student Services if unsure

Check CMMC Course Handbook on the CMMC homepage under the Registration Tab for requirements.



U of W, U of M, CMU, USB Deadline

- ▶ MARCH 1st!!!
- ▶ Applying by this dates ensures you are eligible for their grades-based general entrance scholarships (\$1000+)
- ▶ U of W Application-Based Entrance Scholarships with values ranging from \$100-\$40,000

MARCH 1st deadline

- ▶ You DO NOT need a transcript if you are going to U of M or U of W



IMPORTANT: U of W Applicants

Application-Based Scholarship Deadline: March 1st

Hi Grade 12 Student Services who have **APPLIED or are planning on APPLYING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF WINNIPEG,**

Did you know the **U of W offers many scholarships and awards for students entering the U of W,** with values ranging from **\$100 - \$48,000!!!** Although you will automatically be considered for the grades-based entrance scholarship if you apply by March 1st, we **STRONGLY ENCOURAGE** you to apply for the other entrance awards they offer.

You must complete a SEPARATE APPLICATION for these **entrance awards,** and the **DUE DATE IS MARCH 1st.** Note that you need to apply to the U of W **FIRST** in order to be able to access the application. Note that you will be asked to provide a **reference letter** from a teacher, coach, extra-curricular supervisor, etc. so you will want to get on this as soon as possible.



 - The graduation gown size is determined based on the wearer's height, ensuring that the gown reaches the mid-calf. Height measurement is taken with flat shoes or barefoot, excluding heels, and spans from the top of the head to the bottom of the foot
 - If on the cusp between two sizes, do not size up.
