

WINNIPEG POLICE SERVICE



Police Constable

- 18 years of age.
- Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident (Landed Immigrant).
- Grade 12 Diploma; G.E.D. Certificate; or equivalent*
- No involvement in any criminal activity within the last two years (including illegal drugs).
- No criminal record for which a Pardon has not been granted.
- Valid Class 5 Driver's License (Full).
- No more than four demerits on Driver's Abstract as assessed by the Winnipeg Police Service.
- Must meet current Winnipeg Police Service vision standards.
- Must meet current Winnipeg Police Service hearing standards.
- Successful completion of the Winnipeg Police Service - Physical Abilities Test

* Recognized Canadian assessment services are members of the [Alliance of Credential Evaluation Services of Canada](#) (ACESC). They offer a variety of assessment products including basic/general or comprehensive/detailed reports. While either type of report can be submitted, only a basic/general report is required. If you are not submitting proof of Grade 12 completed within Canada, we require you to submit proof of a full-time, two year post-secondary program completed in Canada.

POLICE CONSTABLE CONTINUED



Preferred Qualifications:

- Applicants possessing any of the preferred qualifications noted below, in addition to all of the required minimum qualifications, will be considered more competitive during the selection process.
- Post-secondary education
- Demonstrated commitment to the community through volunteer experience
- Police-related work or volunteer experience
- Stable work history involving a position of leadership, responsibility and trust
- Work and/or volunteer experience involving significant interaction with the public
- Knowledge of a second language or culture
- Applied knowledge of computers and basic keyboard skills

Auxiliary Cadet

Salary: ~\$60,000

Training: 10 weeks

Cadets are civilians with peace officers status that work throughout the city to enhance the Service's visual presence, build positive relationships in the community and allow police members to focus on core police duties. A Cadet's daily activities vary and include:

- conducting neighbourhood foot patrols
- guarding crime scenes
- directing traffic
- assisting in ground searches
- enforcing provincial statutes and municipal by-laws
- referring citizens to assisting agencies

Central Processing Officer

Salary: ~\$ 67,000 - 82,000

Training: Written test, Physical test

The Central Processing Officer (CPO) plays a key role in the arrest process through the admission, monitoring, arrest and bail hearings of prisoners in the Central Processing Unit.

The main responsibilities of the CPO include providing for the custody, care and control of prisoners in a police facility or when conducting external escorts. As a designated peace officer, this position is responsible for ensuring the security and good order of the facility is maintained as well as providing direction to and supervision of offenders. These functions are provided in a twenty-four-hour operation with rotating shifts in a challenging environment.

Salary ~ \$63,000 - \$85,000

Training: 5 weeks

Call Takers have excellent active listening, conflict resolution, and multi-tasking skills. They possess critical thinking abilities and are able to react calmly and effectively to emergency situations. Call Takers are the critical link between members of the community and the public safety services they require, including other emergency response agencies such as the Winnipeg Fire Paramedic Service.


Civilian Positions:

SALARY

Competitive Salary

The CAF offers competitive salaries. Your skills, knowledge, experience and training can impact your starting salary. As a new direct entry recruit in the Regular Force, you could earn anywhere from \$3,614 to \$5,304 per month, while you complete basic training.

Once you are fully trained for your chosen occupation, your salary will continue to increase based on your time in the military, rank and acquired skills. Starting salaries are based on equivalent careers for entry level positions within the private sector. The benefits of continuous professional development, training, healthcare and pension from the moment you enroll separate the CAF from every other private sector opportunity.

Paid Education

If you enroll through one of our paid education plans, you will receive at least \$30,200, while you complete your paid education. Depending on your enrolment plan, this could be significantly more. Your pay also increases once you graduate. Take a look at some of our [paid education](#) plans to find out more about pay and benefits for students.

Signing Bonus

Some of our [featured occupations](#) in the Regular Force offer a signing bonus. To be eligible for a signing bonus, you must meet the specific criteria for the occupation. These criteria may include: the possession of a technical or vocational qualification that is in part based upon practical work experience and that closely corresponds to the majority of advanced military occupation training; the possession of a diploma, certificate or degree issued by a Canadian post-secondary educational institution in an area that closely corresponds to a majority of the initial military occupation training; the military training and experience that is necessary for immediate employment – without further training or experience – in the military occupation; or being a licenced professional. Criteria may be different for each occupation. It is recommended that you [speak to a local recruiter](#) who can help you evaluate your potential entitlement to a signing bonus.



Some of the top end salaries in multiple military categories can earn upwards of ~27,000 per month!!

OVERVIEW

Whether you're thinking of going to college or getting your post-grad degree, the CAF can help you get there with one of our paid education programs. **If you qualify, the CAF will pay 100% of your school fees, including your tuition, books and academic equipment!** Meanwhile, you'll earn a competitive annual salary and an excellent benefits package including health, dental, vision care and much more. Please note that online distance learning is not currently considered for paid education programs with the CAF. Cooperative education programs are considered for subsidized training only in certain cases. Please talk to a recruiter.

Military Commitment after Graduation

After you graduate from one of our paid education programs, you will be guaranteed a job in your field with the CAF. Your salary will continue to increase through professional experience and promotions. Each program requires two months of service for every month of paid education.
