
During Ukrainian Club, students painted Pysanka which are traditional Easter eggs.


Grade 1/2's celebrating 100 days of learning for the 2022 – 2023 school year.

During the Cooking Program some students are learning some essential skills, such as learning to cut with a knife safely.




Students of the Cooking Program just finished working hard at improving their cutting skills. Now they get to sit and enjoy their veggies and dip and have some social time with one another.
