

CONDUCT AT BOARD MEETINGS

- (1) No trustee shall disobey the rules of the board or a decision of the chair or of the board on any question or order to practice or upon the interpretation on the rules of the board; and in case a trustee persists in any such disobedience after having been called to order by the chair, the chair shall forthwith put the question, with no amendment, adjournment or debate being allowed, "That such trustee be ordered to leave his/her seat for the duration of the meeting of the board", but if the trustee apologizes he/she may, by vote of the board, be permitted to retake his/her seat.
- (2) No trustee shall use offensive words or speak disrespectfully in or against the division, the board, any employee, or against any trustee.
- (3) No trustee shall have the power to direct or interfere with the performance of any work for the board.
