• Staffing:

- 1819 sections determined. Expected decreased enrolment from 365 to 326 for September 2018 resulting in a reduction of roughly 1.5 teachers. This decrease is the result of a large group of grade 12 students graduating and a small group of grade 9 students entering. Enrolment expected to increase and remain steady as of 2019. Staffing has not been finalized pending updates from staff currently on leave.
- Mme Bénédicte Gonon has announced her resignation from the RETSD. We wish her all the best in her new endeavours in WSD.
- Mme Danielle Camara and M. Paul Medienwo will complete their term assignments in June 1718.
- 1819 Master schedule completed and will be finalized pending student scheduling in late May.
