#### Vice president:

- Trish and Chelsea met with Tim the PE coordinator
  - He recommended Playgrounds R Us
  - Prices range from \$37-80k
  - He also recommends playground repair and maintenance

- Bailey – The division doesn't help with playground maintenance
- Bailey – we can aim for one level but pivot to another if fundraising results lag
- We would likely aim for the Eclipse Net Climber (\$64k) or the Lunar Burst Net Climber (\$64k)
- Meghan – we should be transparent with families about our 3+ year timeline
- Next steps:
  - Bailey would write to the board to initiate our ability to raise funds
  - Maintenance Dept to be included as well
  - Chelsea to start a grant application
  - Chelsea will get comparison quotes

## **Fundraising**

- Plans for upcoming fundraisers
  - We'll likely do an M&M fundraiser
    - Chelsea can enter the menu into MunchaLunch
  - We may look at Purdy's Chocolate
    - Angus nursery recently did well with this
  - Kernels Popcorn as well – though limited volume potential
    - We made \$488 with Kernels in 2018-19
- Update on Giving Tuesday (Anita)

- We missed our window this year
- The school board doesn't condone us collecting money via websites
- Chicken finger update (Chelsea)
  - Prairie Chef Gourmet
  - Chelsea's husband's company – recently acquired
  - Best chicken fingers in town
  - Pre-cooked, easy to reheat
  - Your kids will love them
  - The food is frozen, so pickup is time-sensitive
  - We'd sell via MunchaLunch
  - Casey is thinking launch January 15, which the vendor can accommodate
    - Selling will run for 2 weeks
  - We'll sell \$13.5 boxes for \$20 (32% margin)
    - And \$58 boxes for \$75 (31% margin)
- 50/50
  - Will kick off Monday, Dec 11 via Funding Change
  - Funds need to be deposited into a committee member's bank account then transferred to the school
    - Anita volunteered
- Used book sale

## Hot lunch

- November hot lunch update
  - Made \$236 (23%) on \$1,046 of sales
    - 109 orders placed
  - Sep/Oct/Nov – made \$641 (22%) on \$2,980
- Upcoming hot lunch
