## III. Principal' Report – Marjorie Millman

Current enrollment – approximately 623 students: ~150 students opted for remote learning.

- The move of all schools to Orange level meant that schools in Manitoba had to work to meet the new pandemic guidelines. This included all students 2 metres apart, continued mask wearing for students in grades 4 and up, and ongoing hand hygiene. To move students 2 metres apart this means that many of our students had to either change classrooms or teachers now have to teach across multiple classrooms. This is an "all hands on deck" situation. Teachers, specialists, and support staff are all having to play a role to ensure that your students are still receiving a quality education. It has not been easy. We have truly appreciated the kind feedback that we've received from our school community.
- We hired a new school Security Monitor. Mrs. T. spends her days circulating throughout the school and managing the traffic at the front doors as they are locked all day.
- ESMP had our first Covid case. A letter went home to all families with any information that could be shared.
- There will be no school on November 20, 23, & 24th. ESMP had originally booked the 20th as a professional learning day. When the province declared that all schools would get 3 more professional learning days for planning with two days having to occur before the December break, the RETSD chose the 23rd and 24th as coordinated days. We will spend this time planning for students who are in class and who are remote learning.
- The report card portal will open on December 7th. We are encouraging all families to familiarize themselves with the Parent Portal on Tyler as we will only be copying a limited when absolutely needed.

- Virtual Parent Conferences will take place on December 10th and 11th. This will happen on TEAMS. You will be getting an invitation from Conference Manager our school conference booking system in early December.
- RETSD now has a language option. You can select from several languages that our students and families speak in the division. We have found that this works better on Google Chrome and Safari. Please share this exciting news.
- A reminder that there will not be a winter concert this year. Our fingers remain crossed that we may be able to do something in the spring.
- Because of Covid, ESMP is following the direction of the Winnipeg Cheer Board and we
  will not be preparing Hampers this holiday season. We are looking at some alternatives
  to be able to support some of the families in our community.

- Our committees continue to work on school goals as best as we can given our current circumstances.
