## 6. Principals' Report - Marjorie Millman

Current enrollment - approximately 652 students
Public Health offered a Covid vaccination clinic at ESMP for students in grades 7 \& 8.

- Public Health is also catching up on all of the vaccines that were missed for students in different grades. Therefore, we will be seeing a lot of them this year as they try and get up to date.
- We also had Vision and Hearing screening completed for students in various grades to catch up on this as well.

Mme. Gagnon brought back her famous Halloween gym for all K-5 students to celebrate Halloween. She very kindly rearranged her timetable to make sure that all early years students had the opportunity to participate.

ESMP recognized Remembrance Day with a beautiful online ceremony that included contributions from many classes.

Volleyball will be wrapping up soon. It has been nice to have our middle years students playing sports again even if it was an abbreviated season.

After December 5th, as per Public Health orders, only students who are vaccinated will be able to participate in after school sports.

ESMP's French immersion team has a Monitrice de langue (language monitor). As an FI team, we are planning three "blitzes" to promote more use of oral language

As a school we are planning whole school blitzes on belonging. The next blitz will be on generosity. Students who are caught supporting other students, doing kind acts, etc. are rewarded with a Viper bite. Random draws are done weekly and there is a weekly class prize.

We will be starting band classes again with instruments in 2nd term.

Reports cards go home on November 29th and virtual parent conferences are December $2 \& 3$.
