-Playground Initiative Update

- -CSA is still fundraising for the playground equipment project. The CSA applied for a few grants but did not get approved for any so far. There is still one pending grant application that we are waiting to be reviewed.
- We have also received a verbal commitment from Jeff Browaty to commit 50% of the remaining cost of equipment, if the CSA can fundraise the other half.
- Chelsea has also brought forward an example of a fundraising campaign letter that another organization used to raise funds in a tiered donation format. This is something we will discuss further.
- -Another previous discussion was to create an art installation to recognize larger donations towards the climber. We will discuss this further as a possibility with the tiered donation letter.

Maker Space Project Update
