

## START-UP FUNDS TO SCHOOLS FOR ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATIONS

Any school that plans to hold any anniversary celebration must inform the board of trustees, and may be eligible for start-up funds. Any school receiving start-up funds shall provide a report, including a financial statement, to the board of trustees at the conclusion of the event. A request for an anniversary celebration that is not specified below will be considered on an individual basis, in accordance with this paragraph.

The superintendent or designate will be the formal liaison between the anniversary planning committee and the school division.

Any school that plans to hold any one of a 10<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> or 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration, which is approved by the board, will be provided with start-up funds up to \$500.

Any school that plans to hold a 25<sup>th</sup>, 50<sup>th</sup>, 75<sup>th</sup>, or 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration, which is approved by the board, will be provided with start-up funds of up to \$1,000.

The grant will be provided on the condition that the start-up funds are refunded at the conclusion of the event.

On the occasion of a schools' 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary, the school division will supply and install an appropriate commemorative plaque to signify this milestone.
