Mr. Moffat's Grade 3 and 4 class recently participated in a field trip to the Manitoba Legislative Building! During our visit, students toured the building and learned about its history and significance in our province. The children had many questions about the Golden Boy! They also had the opportunity to meet our local elected representative, which helped them make real-world connections to government and leadership.

A highlight of the trip was a one-hour classroom session focused on democracy. Students explored how decisions are made, the roles of different levels of government, and the importance of active citizenship.

This experience supported our Social Studies curriculum by deepening students' understanding of governance, community involvement, and the responsibilities of citizens. It also encouraged students to think critically about how they can contribute to their communities.

We have another exciting field trip, this time science themed, at the end of April!

Imagining, Creating, and Persuading!

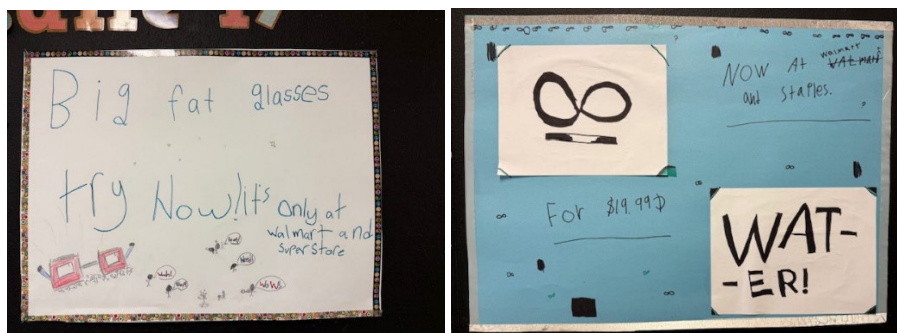
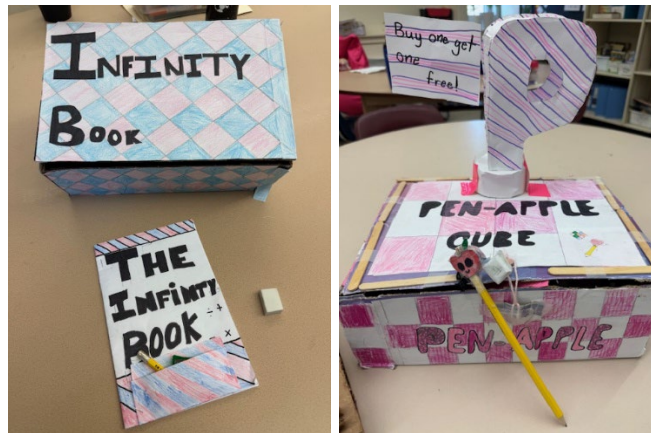

Preschool Growing and Learning Days – École Neil Campbell School is among 5 schools who will be hosting this event for children beginning kindergarten in September. The event is on **Wednesday, April 29, 2026** from 4:30pm-6:30pm. See the attached PDF for details.

Notice to Fee for Service and Grade 6 Students regarding bussing: - Fee-For-Service applications must be submitted to the Transportation Department by **June 30th** of each school year and will be reviewed on an individual basis. Grade 6 students currently being transported by a RETSD school bus will **not** be eligible for free busing in Grade 7. According to the Manitoba Education Public Schools Act Regulation (M.R. 259/2006), Grade 7 to 12 students living **within** the city limits are **not** eligible for school bus transportation, however Fee-for-Service may be available. If you are considering this option, please submit a Transportation Application – **Fee-For-Service 2026-27 Form B**. Forms are available from the school office or on the Transportation section located on divisional home page. Applications are not rolled over therefore, you must (re)-apply every year.

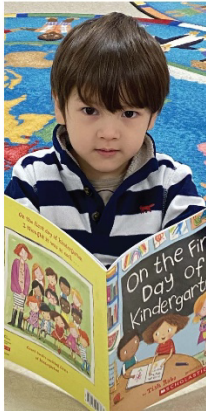
