Parking: Please do not stop near our Patrols; doing so makes it unsafe for them and the students they are helping to cross safely. 

A message from Mr. Moffatt's grade 3 & 4 classes in Room # 14

We have been busy in Math class. The students are perfecting their division skills, and we learned that division and multiplication are very closely related! In fact... one strategy to solve division problems is to work backwards and use multiplication! Many kids love this strategy, because they are already familiar with multiplication.

But wait - there's more! We are also learning how to interpret data and graphs. Some graphs even look like pies! We are relating these math lessons to zones of regulation, and strategies to help children move from the yellow zone to the green zone. We can learn strategies for math at the same time as learning strategies in health.

Brrr! It's cold outside!

We sure have been busy this last month with I love to read activities. We had guest reader Brigitte Lenoski (former French teacher and hobby artist) come to read to our classroom and teach us about art.



In science we have been learning about the properties of sound and will soon be building our own musical instruments in class.



We have also gotten started on our classroom garden. Students have had the opportunity to prepare planters with soil, nutrients and fertilizer as well as plant seeds in peat pellets.

For Social Studies, we have been conducting a research project on Nunavut and the Inuit people. We are hoping to have a Power Point presentation ready sometime in March. Festival du Voyageur is also fast approaching, and we are excited to go on a field trip to experience some métis music and history.

In Math we have been working on practicing our multiplication and division facts as well as learning strategies to solve two by one-digit multiplications.
