Important School Reminders & Announcements

Volunteering at École Neil Campbell School: Updated guidelines have been put in place for the new school year, throughout the River East Transcona School Division (RETSO). These guidelines ensure a safe and secure environment for our students is maintained. The annual registration process helps ensure that schools and HR maintain accurate records and that volunteers understand their responsibilities, expectations, confidentiality obligations, and applicable screening requirements.

Beginning June 1, 2026 all volunteers are required to have the following items cleared by the Human Resources Department of the River East Transcona School Division (RETSO) before they are allowed to volunteer during the new school year. Early completion of these requirements will help ensure volunteers are approved and available to support school activities, field trips, extracurricular programs, and classroom initiatives at the start of the school year.

- An RETSO Volunteer Application Form (available in the school office).
- A Child Abuse Registry (CAR) check (available in the school office).
- A Criminal Record Check (CRC) with Vulnerable Sector Check (VSC) (completed online if living in Winnipeg, or at the RCMP district office if living outside of Winnipeg).
- Certificate of Completion for the following mandatory online training:
 - Commit to Kids or Respect in School (volunteer’s choice).
 - Respect in Sport Online Training Program (required for volunteers applying for Coaching roles).

Next steps: Please come into the school office to complete the required forms **before June 26, 2026**. You can also pick up a “Toolkit for Volunteers”; this guide will help you through the process of applying and submitting the documents. Provincial Nutrition Program – As we approach the end of the school year, RETSD is pleased to be able to provide a one-time take-home hamper for all our students. Each hamper will contain a selection of simple, nutritious items, including canned chickpeas, canned tomato paste, potatoes, apples, shelf-stable milk, individual cereal portions, and instant oatmeal packets. These hampers are part of our division's nutrition program. **Hampers will be delivered on Friday, June 26.** The hamper contents are considered low risk for common allergens. As all items are individually packaged, any products that a student cannot consume due to allergies may be discarded or shared with another family member at the family's discretion.
