**Notice to Fee for Service and Grade 6 Students regarding bussing:** - Fee-For-Service applications must be submitted to the [Transportation Department](#) by **June 30<sup>th</sup>** of each school year and will be reviewed on an individual basis. According to the Manitoba Education Public Schools Act Regulation (M.R. 259/2006), Grade 7 to 12 students living **within** the city limits are **not** eligible for school bus transportation, however Fee-for-Service may be available. If you are considering this option, please submit a Transportation Application – **Fee-For-Service 2026-27 Form B**. Forms are available from the school office or on the Transportation section located on divisional home page.
