What's Happening at École Neil Campbell School?

March Mathlympics! - École Neil Campbell School is participating in a math bingo for the month of March. Students are also bringing home an Olympic themed sheet that can be completed together as a family. Here is a sample of the activities students will be completing in class.

Mathlympics Bingo		
Recipe Find a recipe from one of the competing countries to create! (example: food "knows" or "sings"; create your own recipe) 	Event Graphing Pick an Olympic event and compare the statistics between 2 countries or athletes. 	Shape-scape Create a skyline and/or Olympic venue of the host city using different materials in your classroom. (try using recyclable items or create your own 2D & 3D shapes) 
Mascot Design & Measurement Design and measure your own Olympic mascot. 	Flag Design As a class, you will create a flag using patterns, shapes, or colours. 	Number Day Pick a country and find out how many medals they won. (How many different ways can you represent this number?) 
Graphing Question As a class, small group or individually, come up with a question to ask others about the Olympics. Example: "What is your favourite sport?" Once you have tallied up your numbers, create a graph to show your answers. 	Create a Pattern As a class, small group or individually, use the colours of the Olympic rings to create a pattern. 	Design a Game As a class, small group or individually create an Olympic-themed game. Once you have designed a game and come up with the rules for how to play, you can play it as a class.

Notice to Fee for Service and Grade 6 Students regarding bussing: - Fee-For-Service applications must be submitted to the [Transportation Department](#) by **June 30th** of each school year and will be reviewed on an individual basis. Grade 6 students currently being transported by a RETSD school bus will **not** be eligible for free bussing in Grade 7. According to the Manitoba Education Public Schools Act Regulation (M.R. 259/2006), Grade 7 to 12 students living **within** the city limits are **not** eligible for school bus transportation, however Fee-for-Service may be available. If you are considering this option, please submit a Transportation Application – **Fee-For-Service 2026-27 Form B**. Forms are available from the school office or on the Transportation section located on divisional home page. Applications are not rolled over therefore, you must (re)-apply every year.
