Grade 7 Vision Screening

A vision screening for all grade 7 students will be carried out on Tuesday, November 26, 2024. The vision screening program is designed to detect signs of possible vision difficulties which may interfere with your child's learning and school progress. It is not intended to be a substitute for the vision examination performed by an Optometrist or Ophthalmologist (eye doctor) and glasses will

not be prescribed at this time. Students wearing prescription glasses will not be screened. Following the initial screening, you may receive a letter from the school division recommending that your child see an eye doctor for further assessment. CLICK ON THE LINK TO FILL OUT FORM:
