Possible Transit Strike

We know many of our students take the Transit bus to and from school. We wanted to make certain you were aware that the Amalgamated Transit Union Local 1505 (ATU), which represents Winnipeg Transit bus operators and maintenance staff has set a strike deadline of 12:01 am. Monday, December 11. An ATU strike would immediately stop all Transit service, and no Winnipeg Transit buses would run on any routes. In the event of an ATU strike, the City will not be attempting to replicate or replace any portion of Transit service and Transit users will need to be prepared to find alternative means of transportation during this time.
