## PowerSchool Update

In our previous updates about the PowerSchool cybersecurity incident, we mentioned that PowerSchool would be sending emails to students, parents/guardians, and educators whose information was involved in the incident it previously experienced. We are aware that PowerSchool has now begun sending out notices to students and parents/guardians. You may shortly receive this notice or may have already received it.

We understand from PowerSchool that the email was or will be sent from one of the following similar email addresses: <u>ps-sis-incident@mail.csid.com</u>; <u>ps-sis-incident@mail2.csid.com</u>; <u>ps-sis-incident@mail2.csid.com</u>. If you receive or have received an email from any one of these email addresses with the subject line "PowerSchool Cybersecurity Incident", we have been assured by PowerSchool that it is a legitimate email.

#### Notice to Grade 6 and Fee For Service Students RE: BUSING

Grade 6 students currently being transported by a RETSD school bus will not be eligible for free busing in Grade 7. According to the Manitoba Education Public Schools Act Regulation (M.R. 259/2006). Grade 7 to 12 students living within the city limits are not eligible for school bus transportation. Fee-for-Service may be available. If you are considering this option, please submit a Transportation Application – Fee-For-Service 2025-26 Form B. Forms are available from the school office or on the Transportation section located on divisional home page at <u>www.retsd.mb.ca</u>. Applications are not rolled over therefore, you must (re)-apply every year.

Fee-For-Service applications must be submitted to the Transportation Department by June 30 of each school year and will be reviewed on an individual basis.
