If you have concern that you wish share, please reach out to your student's teacher to arrange a separate appointment as it is not possible to have a private conversation with many families in the room.
- Please schedule your appointment your student's homeroom teacher (instructions on how to book are in the attached document). All our specialist teachers and our student services staff will be available as a drop-in basis before or after your appointment, you do not need to book with them.
