We wear orange to remember the Indigenous children who were sent to residential schools, many who never returned, and to honour survivors, their families and their communities. National Day for Truth and Reconciliation provides an important learning opportunity for all of us to take time to pause and reflect; and have important conversations about Canada's history of residential schools. The heartbreaking tragedy of residential schools reminds us of the systemic efforts to eliminate language, culture and values of Indigenous peoples. It is imperative we work together to understand the truth and continue the path of Reconciliation through Treaty Education. At École John Henderson Middle School we are committed to teaching about treaties, relationships, culture, ways of knowing and reconciliation. These teachings are woven into the curriculum of every grade level throughout the school year, not just this week. While many activities took place this week, we understand that this is an ongoing focus that is important for all our students and our school community.
