**3:20 p.m.** Dismissal for the day. Please be aware that the school busses tend to run behind schedule as students learn where their stops are.

# 2025-2026 ÉJHMS STUDENT FEES

Every student pays a fee of \$50.00 and will cover the cost of Interactive Start/special events, yearbook, house team t-shirt, agenda, locks, and consumables.

<u>Art Students Only</u> - There is a fee of \$30.00 for students in art to cover costs such as paint, papers, oil pastels and any other supplies needed for the year.

<u>Band Students Only</u> - There is a fee of \$14.00 for a Band Method Book for Grade 6 and 8 only. The school rental fee for students playing baritone saxophone, bass clarinet, French horn, euphonium, and tuba is \$150.00. The fee for students playing percussion is \$80.00. All other instruments are the responsibility of the families.

Student fees can be paid by cash or cheque to École John Henderson Middle School at meet the teacher evening on Tuesday, September 2 or to the homeroom teacher on the first day of school.
