## **RE: Call for Council members and notice of Executive Elections**

At this time of year, the Lord Wolseley Parent Partnership Council (LWPPC) starts planning for the for the 2019-2020 school year. On Monday June 10, 2019 we will be holding our final meeting of the 2018-2019 school year, which is when the executive elections take place.

LWPPC is comprised of family members from the Lord Wolseley School community and administrative representatives. **Please note, that our council has had several active members graduate as students move on. Without new members attending meetings, Council will not be able to continue to organize events.**

There are a multitude of ways that you can join us; whether you attend a meeting, volunteer for one for the sub-committees, or participate at the executive level, there is ALWAYS room for more members. It is fun and rewarding. We meet once a month for a couple of hours in the evening to share ideas, plan events, and work together to provide opportunities and resources for all LWS students. We have not yet set the schedule for next year's meetings. **If you are interested but have not been able to attend on Mondays, please let us know. If childcare is limiting your attendance, please also let us know as we may be able to make arrangements for child minding at the school during meetings.**

LWPPC also includes 3 elected positions: Chairperson, Treasurer, and Secretary. Executive Elections will take place this year at the June council meeting to be held on Monday, June 10th at 6:30 pm in the school library.

Here are some of the guidelines to be considered for this process:

- Nominations can be put forward in advance of this meeting or at the meeting
- Advance nominations can be sent to the school secretary by sending an e-mail to [sjohnsonline@retsd.mb.ca](mailto:sjohnsonline@retsd.mb.ca)
- Any person may nominate their own self or another. All nominations must be seconded.
- Election to the Executive will occur by a majority vote of a quorum of voting members present at the June Council meeting
- The term of the Executive member shall be for one school calendar year. This is a minimal time commitment. The committee meets monthly for 1-2 hours.
