  - o a student/family or
  - designated as a donation. All orders that are purchased as a donation will be donated to the Transcona Food Bank (209 Yale Avenue West)

All vegetable bundles will be delivered to Harold Hatcher School in the morning on October 7<sup>th</sup>. Volunteers will be required to organize the vegetables into their respective bundles and to assist with pick up. Parents/caregivers are asked to pick up the vegetables on October 7<sup>th</sup> between 3:30 and 7:00. Further details to follow.
