Fundraising (Dawn):

-Super Bowl Feedback: Made: \$863.70 profit. Had 2 winners and 3 prizes. We sold 63% of our tickets. There were no tickets left over. So, we do not know who did not bring back their tickets, but we numbered the tickets so we can look it up.

-Idea: is to send out a letter before the tickets go out to see if they want to participate, because it would give us a better idea who to distribute the tickets to, and reduce expenses and the potential for people to just not return unsold tickets. Then if people say they do not want to participate, we just would not send it to them. Then we could send reminders to them. Word the letter like: If you DO NOT want to participate in the fundraiser let us know. We can also add in the letter that there is also an option to just send in a donation. We should do this for every fundraiser that goes out.

-For donations: donations of \$50 are eligible for tax receipts. Does this accumulate throughout the year, or does it have to be a \$50 donation at once? We do not know, Chris will look into.

-Question about incentives for fundraising: Can we do this? Chris says he does not think so, however, there should be no problem if we set a goal, we can do a reward such as a movie in the afternoon, free popcorn day, or something like that.
