


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
All staff received the City of Winnipeg link for classes to use in the honoring of Rosa Parks.

Further, in celebrating Black History Month...


- A bulletin board has been set up in the hallway by the gym celebrating famous Black people.


I Love to Read Month – calendar of events.



Hot Lunches



We use many different games and manipulatives to practice reading and writing rhythms in music class.




During Mr. McPherson's music classes, these Grade 1/2's are busily working at developing their song writing skills.


As students progress in building their habitat using Mine Craft...more and more details are added.

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


Grade 1 / 2 classes learning about Coding.



Mrs. Falconer arranged for a couple of special guests from WISE to come and teach us about coding in the Library. It was very interesting and we were engaged in our learning.






