- Students will be registering with one of the counsellors, using their registration form, transcript and grad tracking form for reference.
- Students will be pulled out from one of their classes. Teachers will let you know which class/which day.

- Everyone needs **30 credits** to graduate!
- If you are missing core credits (English, Math, Phys Ed, CCW, Science) your timetable for next year will be adjusted to include them.

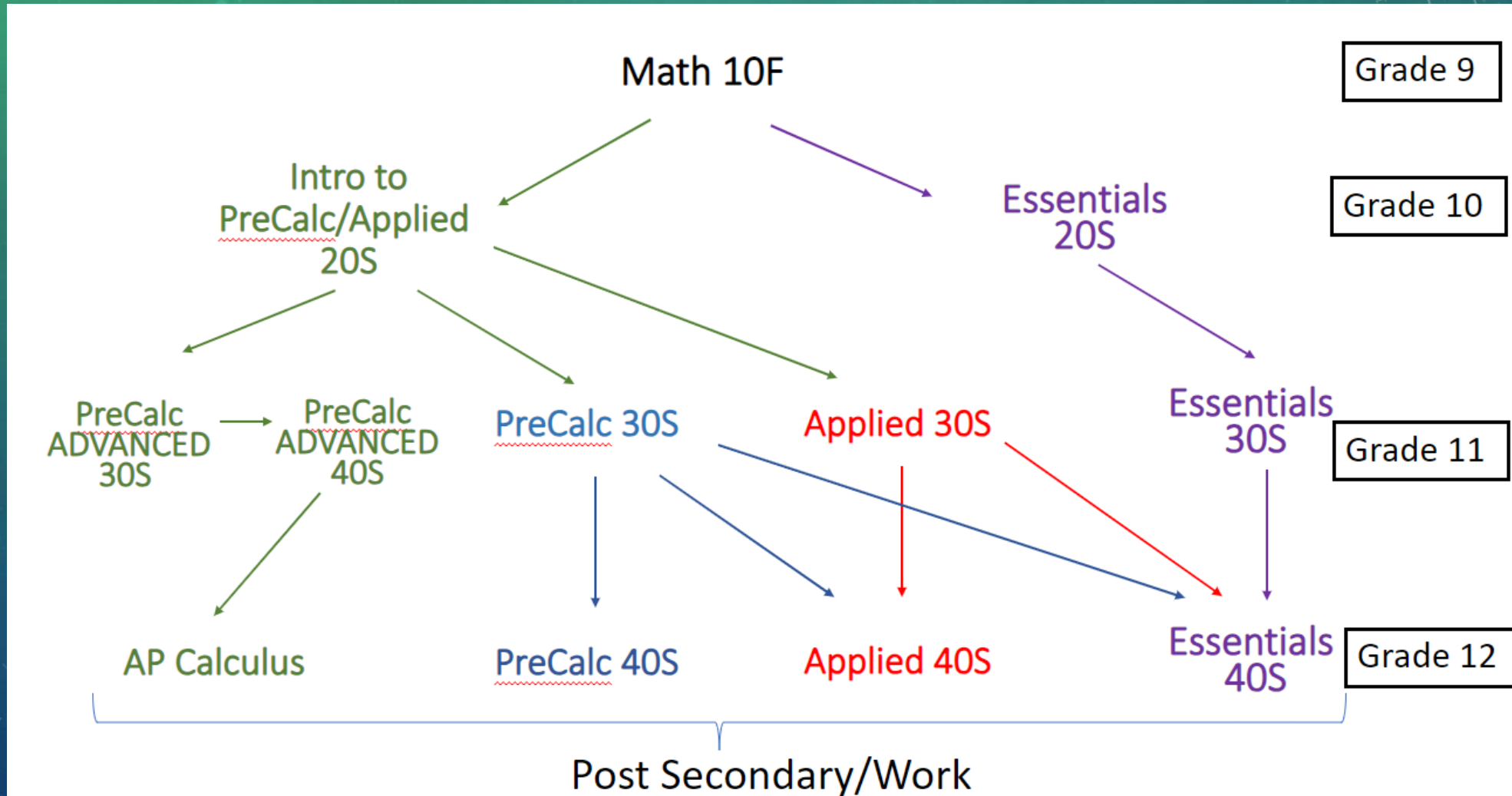

VOCATIONAL PROGRAMMING AVAILABLE IN GRADE 10 - HAIRSTYLING

- Hairstyling Intensive Program at Kildonan East Collegiate begins in Grade 10 and continues in Grade 11 and 12. This is a three year commitment.
- 1 semester at Transcona Collegiate (core courses: ELA, Math, PE, Geo, Science) and 1 semester at KEC.
- ***Hairstyling requires an Expression of Interest form that must be submitted by Tuesday, March 4th, to apply to the program.*** Each program has a maximum enrollment. An expression of interest does not guarantee acceptance into the program.
- See Ms. Knutson or another counsellor for an Expression of Interest form.
- *Please select options courses on the registration form, even if you are applying to the hairstyling program.*

VOCATIONAL INTENSIVE PROGRAMS – NEED TO KNOW

- You must find your own transportation to and from your vocational school.
- Attendance matters!
- You still graduate from Transcona Collegiate.
- You will not be able to take other option courses like sciences, woods, band etc. Your vocational courses are your options courses.
- At the end of Grade 12, you may not have the prerequisite courses for university entrance (it depends on which university you plan to attend).
