## GRADE 4/3 SUPPLY LIST 2023 - 2024

The Grade 4/3 Teacher will be purchasing all school supplies for students in their classrooms.

Supply fees will be used to purchase everything needed in the classroom (crayons, markers, pencils, notebooks, writing folders, etc.). Any remaining funds may be applied to a year end field trip, class activity or a school wide special presentation.

## On the first day of school, your child is asked to bring:

**\$70.00** supply fee per student to purchase consumable school supplies in bulk. We offer three forms of payment for families: cheque, cash or online payment. Receipts will be available on the parent portal after payment is received.

Cheques are payable to Joseph Teres School.

Supply fees can be paid online through the Parent Portal. Click on the Fee & Billing tile, Online Payment icon is on the bottom right. Follow payment instructions. A nominal service fee will be charged upon payment.
