OH NO...MY PASSWORD DOESN'T WORK

You can reset your password!



Things to remember:

- A student portal password reset must be done on a desktop or laptop. NOT on your cell phone.
- Take your time when entering your password, 2 incorrect attempts on your password will lock you out of the system for 24 hours.
- Here is a helpful hint...change your student portal password to make it the same as your Teams password.

HOW TO RESET YOUR STUDENT PORTAL PASSWORD:

- 1. Go to the student portal: <u>https://tyler.retsd.mb.ca/TSI_Live_360/login</u> OR Access the student portal from the TC homepage
- 2. Press "Forgot your login information?"
- 3. You will be prompted to enter your username
 - Year you are supposed to graduate
 - First 5 letters of your last name
 - First letter of your first name
 - @retsdstudent.ca

A link will be sent to your email to reset your password.

4. Access your student email to reset the password.

HOW TO RESET YOUR STUDENT PORTAL PASSWORD (CONTINUED...)



 You cannot reset your password right now, unless you use a desktop or laptop.

Option 1 - The "How to reset your student portal password" information is posted on the TC Teams general channel.
Option 2 - Pick up a paper copy of "How to reset your student portal password" from your TA teacher.

Option 3 – Take a picture of the previous slide that lists the instructions for "How to reset your student portal password".

• Everyone needs **30 credits** to graduate!


 If you are missing core credits (English, Math, Phys Ed, CCW, Science) your timetable for next year will be adjusted to include them.

- We offer courses based on what students choose. Sometimes courses are not available due to lack of interest or conflicts in the schedule.




