Boundary Review

Information is posted on the division website as well as the Herald Hatcher website. Letter along with maps are available at these sites.

1. New Boundary – All families northeast of Wayaota, all families north of Kildare Ave E, all families east of Ravenhurst
2. Students grade 2-5 that are outside of this new catchment will be grandfathered into Harold Hatcher
3. Kindergarten and Grade 1 students that are not in the new catchment area will have to move to new school by 2017 but can make the transition sooner if they choose.
4. Families that have the scenario of a Child that is grandfathered and a child that is in K or gr 1 does have the option to have the child that is grandfathered transfer to the catchment school or stay as is which would mean 2 children in 2 different schools.
5. New registrations or new residents will be redirected to their catchment school – effective immediately
6. School of choice will not be an option until 2019/2020 school year
