

CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

The basic responsibility for curriculum development rests with the provincial department of education. The development of school-initiated courses and student-initiated projects is the responsibility of the individual school in consultation with the appropriate assistant superintendent.

The role of the assistant superintendents in curriculum development shall be to:

- (1) provide leadership to the schools individually and division wide;
- (2) coordinate the planning and decision making so that a common direction of action is provided for the school system;
- (3) communicate information provided by individual principals, teachers or schools to other schools which might effectively use such information;
- (4) communicate to the schools information which affects division plans for curriculum development;
- (5) liaise with the department of education for school initiated courses and student initiated projects approval and course numbering as it relates to graduation requirements.

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
