The River East Transcona School Division believes it is the right and responsibility of students, their parent(s)/legal guardian(s), school personnel, and community members to create and maintain environments that enhance the joy of learning, honour diversity and promote respectful, responsible, and caring environments. Students learn best in an atmosphere in which they feel valued, safe, and accepted. School communities, under the leadership of the principal, will be responsible for the development and implementation of a plan that creates a safe, caring, and respectful school.

The plan will:

- (1) address the wellbeing (emotional, physical, mental, culture) of students with universal, targeted and intensive needs;
- (2) involve the collection and analysis of school data for the purpose of developing and refining the plan;
- (3) be founded on research based effective practices;
- (4) address the professional learning and training needs of school personnel;
- (5) identify a communication strategy;
- (6) be evaluated annually.
