

SCHOOL SAFETY PATROLS

- (1) The principal, or designate, of each early years school shall be responsible for the establishment and maintenance of school safety patrols. This is inclusive of street and bus safety patrols.
- (2) A safety patrol budget shall be established by the board and shall be the responsibility of the superintendent or designate.
- (3) Safety patrol supplies shall be jointly maintained by the superintendent or designate and the school principal or designate.
- (4) A Student Street Safety Patrol Handbook and Bus Patrol Handbook will be maintained and provided to the schools.
- (5) A safety patrol committee shall be established each fall.
- (6) Membership of the safety patrol committee shall be:
 - (i) representative of the superintendent's department;
 - (ii) principal or designates;
 - (iii) director of transportation or designate;
 - (iv) representative of the school patrol supervisors.
- (7) The safety patrol committee shall be responsible for:
 - (i) arranging suitable awards for the safety patrols;
 - (ii) judging and awarding trophies to the safety patrols;
 - (iii) assisting the principals, community organizations, and police in a safety program.
