

SCHOOL SAFETY PATROLS

- (1) The principal of each early years school shall be responsible for the establishment and maintenance of a school safety patrol. This is inclusive of street and bus safety patrols.
- (2) A safety patrol budget shall be established by the board and shall be the responsibility of the superintendent or designate.
- (3) Safety patrol supplies shall be jointly maintained by the superintendent or designate and the school principal or designate.
- (4) A Student Street Safety Patrol Handbook and Bus Patrol Handbook will be maintained and provided to the schools.
- (5) A safety patrol committee shall be established each fall.
- (6) Membership of the safety patrol committee shall be:
 - (a) representative of the superintendent's department;
 - (b) school administrators or designates;
 - (c) director of transportation or designate;
 - (d) police constables representing The City of Winnipeg, and the RCMP;
 - (e) representatives of interested community organizations.
- (7) The safety patrol committee shall be responsible for:
 - (a) arranging suitable awards for the safety patrols;
 - (b) judging and awarding trophies to the safety patrols;
 - enlisting the aid of the area city councillors and the community organizations in student safety;
 - (d) coordinating the work of the police constable assigned to our division for school safety programs;
 - (e) assisting the principals and police in a safety program.
