

ADULT CROSSING GUARDS REGULATION

When determining a school's eligibility for adult crossing guard support, the following formula and process shall be employed.

Formula

Vehicle count (V) x Speed (S) x Traffic Control Device (T) x Centre Boulevard (C) x Yields (Y) x Patrols (P) x Other (O) = Points

A "risk threshold" of 1500 points will be used as a guideline to determine the retaining, removing, or adding of an adult crossing guard.

1. Requests from the public and/or school administration for adult crossing guards shall be directed to the senior administration for study.

- 2. Appointment of adult crossing guards shall be made by the school division.
- 3. Adult crossing guards shall be selected, trained, and supervised by the school division in consultation with the police department.
- 4. The sites where adult crossing guards have been assigned will be reviewed by school division administration, as required.
- 5. When there are new major developments, senior administration, based on advice from school administrators, will monitor the progress of the development and determine the appropriate time to conduct an assessment to apply the formula and determine if the location(s) qualify for adult crossing guards in accordance with section 1
