- Pilot project started in 2021/2022 ENOT early numeracy from observation pilot project
- School events
  - -June 15 1/2/3 field trip Zoo
  - -June 23 Field Day Grade 5 playing a leadership role
  - -June 30 report cards on parent portal will have next year's teachers on report card
- There is approx. 37 students registered for Kindergarten for 2022/2023 school year
- Parent Question: for field day, are there options for parent volunteers?
  - Answer: Volunteers need to have child abuse registry check and criminal record check completed. The plan starting next year, is to have a database of parents who have been approved.
- Parent Question: for field day, can parents observe?
  - Answer: Not for this year. Possible plan for 2022/2023 school year.
- Parent Question: for the Zoo field trip, are there enough volunteers/ adults to supervise?
  - Answer: there are a certain amount of spots and they are filled with teachers and EA's. Volunteers are required to have their child abuse registry check and criminal record check completed

  - -Back to school BBQ time would be about 3:30/4:00. There would be food, chips. A chance for the students to bring their supplies to school, meet their teacher and see their classroom.

- Committee met with Bryan again and received two quotes for two different designs. Each quote was over the \$200,000 mark.
- Went back to Bryan to discuss \$125,000 budget for north side including zip line, saucer swing, fibar engineered wood surfacing that is wheel chair accessible. These are wish list items from the students
- In regards to adding swings on south side, money wise not worth it. Wait until south side is being renovated
- Playgrounds R Us is gifting BHS 2 jets tickets in the Labatte lounge area to be raffled off for fundraising for the playground Over the summer, Julie will apply charitable raffle license.
- Information acquired is that we do not need final quote/design to start applying for grants
- Grants and RETSD requires three quotes from the architect firms, and with the landscapes
- Need to get quotes and designs to send to RETSD, RETSD chooses architect firm.
