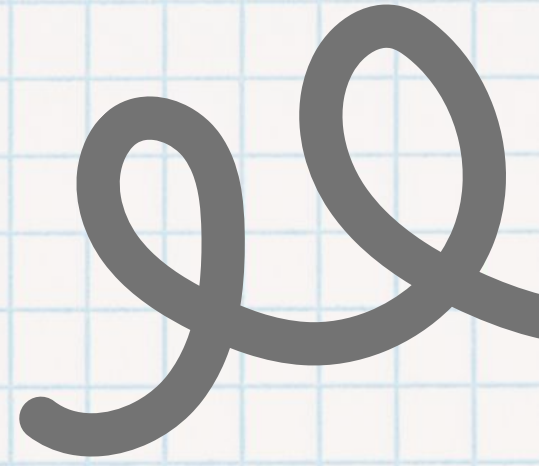
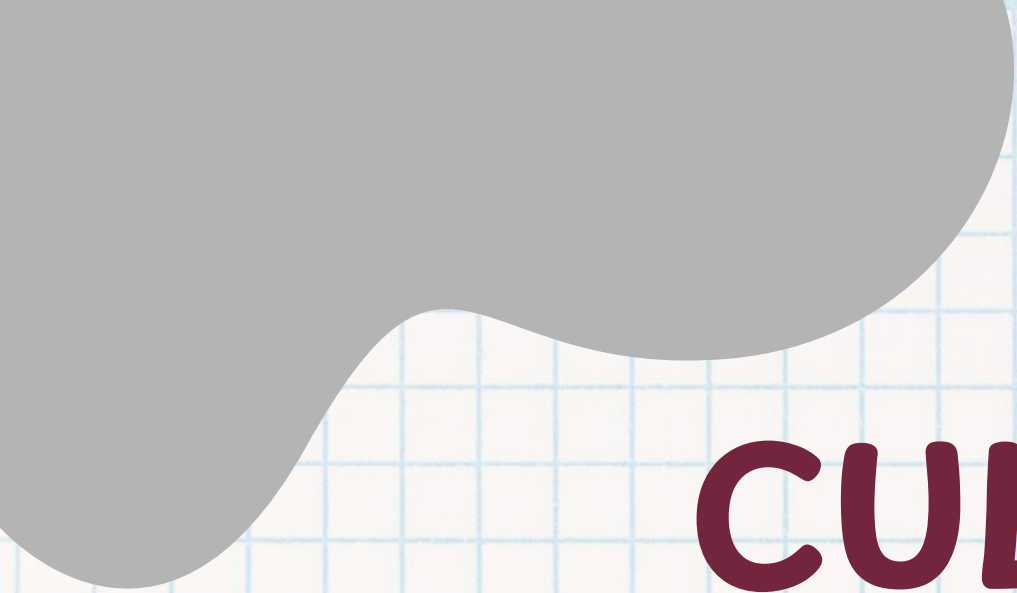
CHESS CLUB

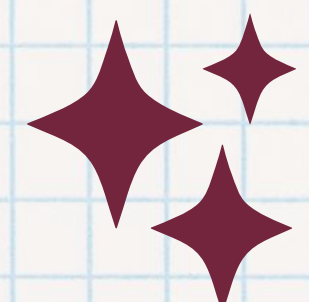


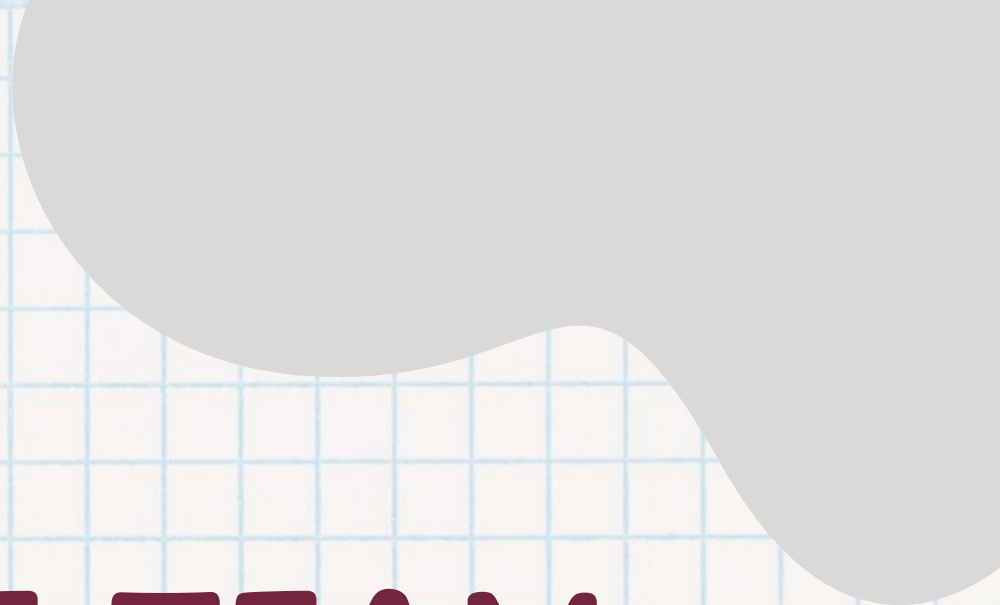
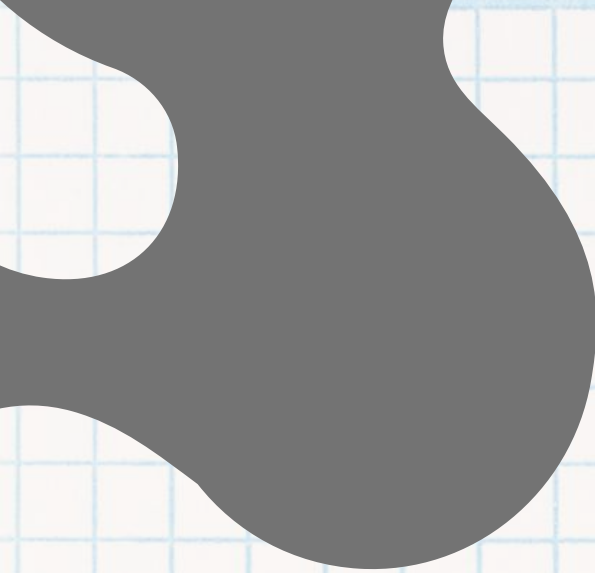
DANCE COMPANY

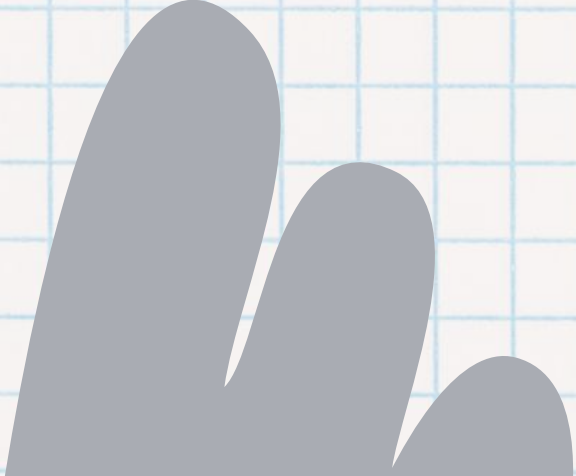
VARSITY DANCE TEAM

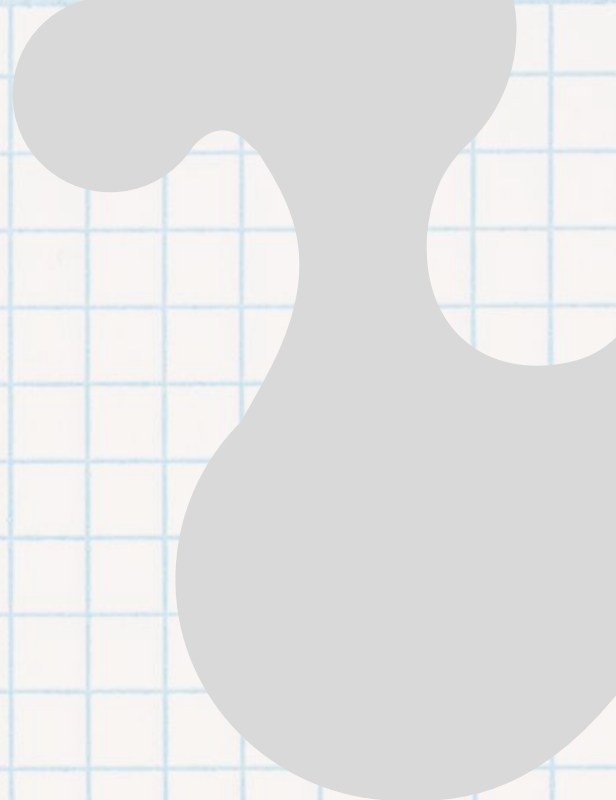

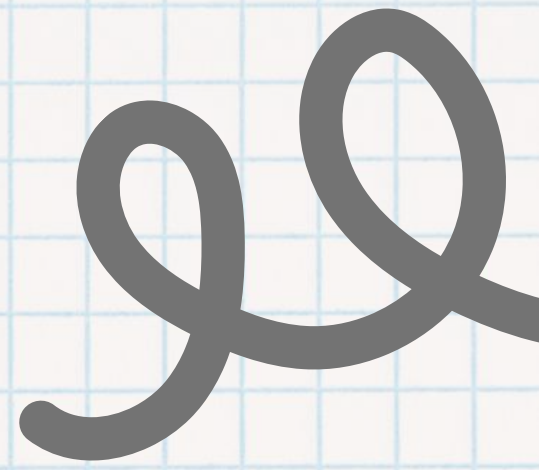
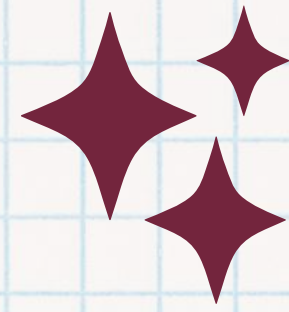
MODEL UNITED NATIONS ASSEMBLY (MUNA)

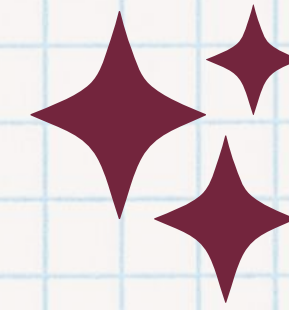
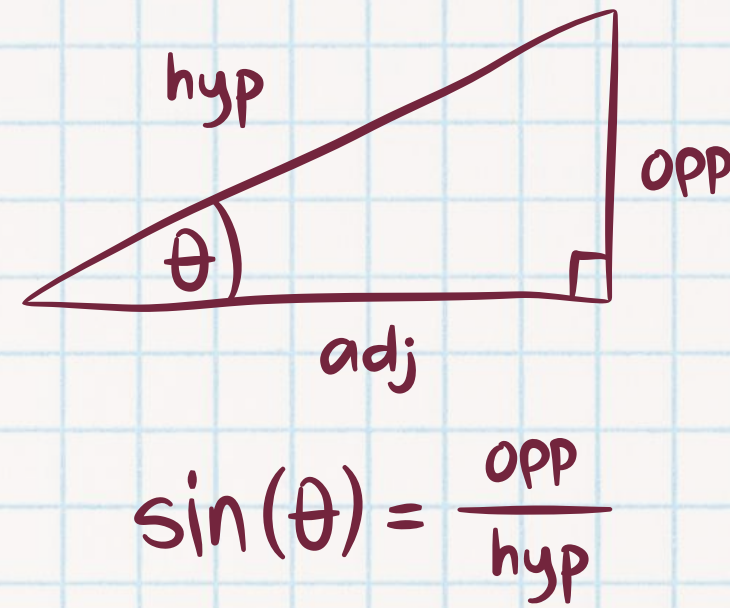
The students will learn about what the lands have to offer for foods, medical and spiritual awareness. This will end with a camping trip in either May or June where students will have more hands-on experience with their environment.

THE PROBLEMATIC PRODIGIES

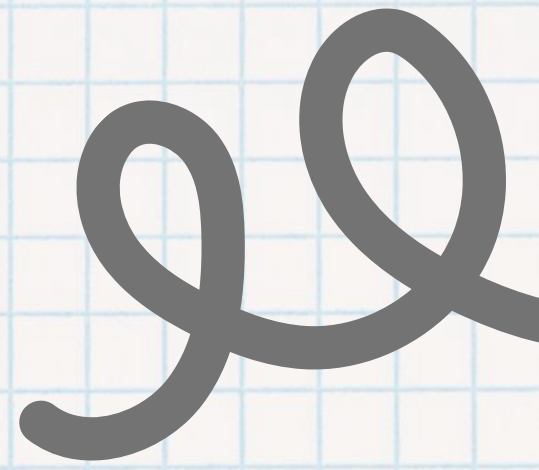
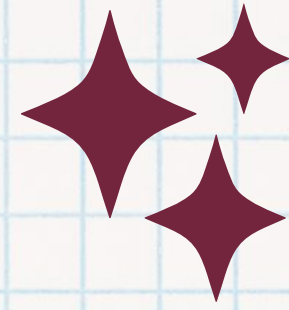
